

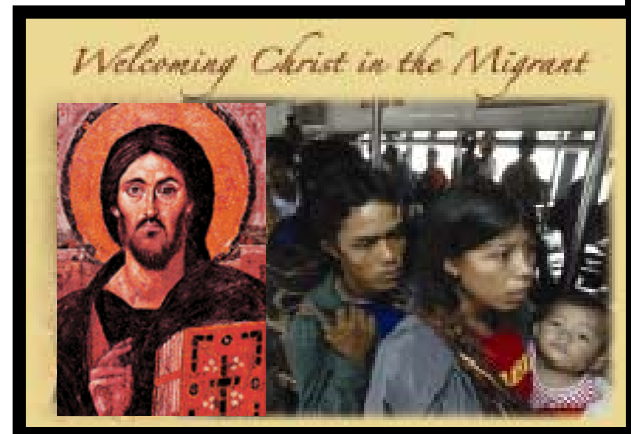
Lenten Rosary of Hope *at the Federal Plaza*
