Dear St. Norbert and Our Lady of the Brook Parish Family,

I write to share some difficult news about Father Matthew Foley, who was a resident at St. Norbert Parish from July 1994 to May 2000. The archdiocese has received an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor while Father Foley was assigned to St. Agatha Parish approximately 30 years ago. In keeping with our child protection policies, Father Foley has been asked to step away from ministry during the investigation. While he strenuously denies this allegation, he has agreed to cooperate with this directive.

Moreover, as is required by our child protection policies, the allegation was reported to civil authorities, the person making the allegation was offered the services of our Victim Assistance Ministry and the archdiocese has begun its investigation. After the civil authorities have finished their work, the archdiocese will complete its investigation and report the results to our Independent Review Board. We ask that you reserve judgement on this allegation until the process has concluded, as those accused are innocent until proven otherwise. We appreciate your patience. Only by conducting a thorough and impartial review can we ensure fairness to all concerned.

I want to stress that the welfare of the children entrusted to our care is our paramount concern. The Archdiocese of Chicago takes all allegations of sexual misconduct seriously and encourages anyone who feels they have been sexually abused by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee to come forward. They will be received with dignity and compassion. Complete information about reporting sexual abuse can be found on the archdiocesan website at www.archchicago.org.
